LOS ANGELES BASED PHOTOGRAPHER AMIR ZAKI RENDERS SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA SUBURBAN LANDSCAPES AND ARCHITECTURE AS FANTASTICAL AND IMPOSSIBLE ARCHITECTONIC STRUCTURES. SPRING THROUGH WINTER PRESENTS HIS INVESTIGA-TIONS INTO THE ENTROPY OF ARCHITECTURE IN A SUITE OF PHOTOGRAPHS OF EXTE-RIOR CANTILEVERED ARCHITECTURE, AERIAL PERSPECTIVE SWIMMING POOLS, AND INTERIOR FIREPLACES. WHILE COMMITTED TO THE MUNDANE, THE WORK IS SUBTLE AND DISORIENTING, TRANSFORMING ARCHITECTURE INTO INEFFECTUAL RELICS. ORIG-INALLY MODERNIST HOMES THAT HAVE BEEN REFACED AND RESTRUCTURED DUE TO MULTIPLE EARTHQUAKES, RENOVATIONS, OR REDECORATION, THE ARTIST'S INTERVEN-TIONS BECOME SCULPTURALLY DYNAMIC, DRAMATIC, AND DYSTOPIC.
