Walter Ingersoll's life and legacy have changed over the years from a collection of drawings and prints to a body of paintings, sculptures, and architectural drawings. Ingersoll's work has been exhibited in numerous solo shows throughout the United States and abroad. His drawings, prints, and architectural designs have been included in major exhibitions such as the 1929 and 1933 Chicago World's Fairs, the 1933 New York World's Fair, the 1939 New York World's Fair, and the 1940 San Francisco Golden Gate International Exposition. Ingersoll's architectural drawings have been exhibited at the Henry Art Gallery, the University of Washington, and the Seattle Art Museum.
