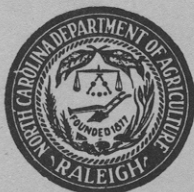

Family SCELIONIDAE

- Telenomus podisi* Ashm. Raleigh, May, bred heteropterous eggs.
**Telenomus clisiocampae* Riley. Bent Creek, Buncombe Co., May 31, 1967, from *Malacosoma americanum* eggs, A. T. Drooz, collector, (U.S. Forest Service).
Trissolcus euschisti Ashm. Raleigh, June.
Trissolcus murgantiae Ashm. Raleigh, October, bred eggs *Murgantia*.
Hadronotus ajax Gir. Raleigh, August, egg parasite of squash bug.
**Trichasius* sp. Beaufort, Mar. 8, 1952, in woods debris, DLW; det. by C. W. F. Muesebeck, USNM.

Platygaster zosine, Lexington, parasite of Hessian fly. C. C. Hill.
